



## 2018-2019 Fellows Scholarship Requirements

Community Oncology Alliance (COA) will sponsor the following number of travel awards annually for the following events/board meetings.

- Annual COA Conference - (6)
- Annual Board Meeting - (2)
- Payer Exchange Summit - (2)

*\*Travel award is only good for airfare and lodging. Meals will be provided during each program. All other meals and ground transportation are the responsibility of the recipient.*

### Applicant Requirements:

1. Applicant must attend the entire session of each event
2. Applicant must attend the Fellows Workshop and all related Fellows educational events scheduled Wednesday evening April 3<sup>rd</sup> thru Friday April 5<sup>th</sup>\*
3. Applicant must be interested in community oncology
4. Applicant must be currently enrolled in a Hematology/Oncology or Radiation Oncology Fellowship Program
5. Applicant asked to write a short paragraph detailing the benefits of attendance

### Submission to Include:

- Updated CV
- One-page personal statement reflecting on each of the following:
  - Personal/Professional goals in attending the meeting
  - Impact that COA has had on your future decision-making
  - Likelihood of practicing in the private, community oncology setting

### Deadline for Each Event:

1. Annual COA Conference: January 2019
2. Board Meeting: July 2019
3. Payer Exchange Summit: August 2019

### Selection Process:

- Application must be received in accordance with above deadlines
- Applications will be reviewed by the Director of Policy Analysis, COA
- Awards and formal announcement via COA newsletter and personal email
- Headshot, if available, desirable

### Poster Presentation Opportunity:

- We are considering a poster presentation by the Fellows during a mandatory Fellows sidebar workshop at our 2019 COA Annual Conference in Orlando if space allows
- Fellows may display work recently presented elsewhere but still relevant
- Each Fellow will be asked to give a 5-7-minute summary of his or her work
- Monetary awards will be presented to all submitters
